

Field Demand:


Due to Field Size Limitations and prescribed Game Nights Schedule from Leagues & Districts. SSUFC has registration caps turning away players, and a minimum 66% away game rate for U15. SSUFC based on need also hosts programs through the Municipality of Kincardine, BWDSB, Southport Church, and Saugeen First Nation.

Affordable Program:

Soccer Registration cost have been able to remain low based on operating cost and field usage rates. Increasing charge rates for field usage would result in a need for increased Registration cost and likely drive registration # lower and make the sport less accessible to all community families.


