By-law 04 – 2026

A By-law to Amend By-law 103-2008 to Establish a Speed
Limit and All-Way Stop Controls on High Street

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, and the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990*, as amended, authorize municipalities to regulate traffic, including speed limits and stop controls.

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Saugeen Shores approved the final design for High Street on November 25, 2024, which included traffic calming measures, all-way stop controls, and a posted speed limit of 30 km/h.

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Saugeen Shores deems it necessary and expedient to amend By-law 103-2008 to implement these measures.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Saugeen Shores enacts as follows:

1. Speed Limit

That Schedule “I” Speed Limits of By-law 103-2008 be amended by adding the following:

Highway	From	To	Speed Limit
High Street	Dominion Lookout Point (Lake Huron)	Grey Street	30 km/h

2. Stop Signs

That Schedule “C” Stop Signs of By-law 103-2008 be amended by adding the following intersections as All-Way Stop Controls:

Stop Street	Intersection
High Street	Victoria Street
High Street	Grey Street
High Street	Grosvenor Street

3. Implementation

Upon approval of this By-law, staff shall:

- Remove all existing 40 km/h speed limit signs and replace them with 30 km/h signs along High Street.
- Install permanent all-way stop signs at the intersections listed above.

4. Effective Date

This By-law shall take effect and come into force on the date of passage.
