

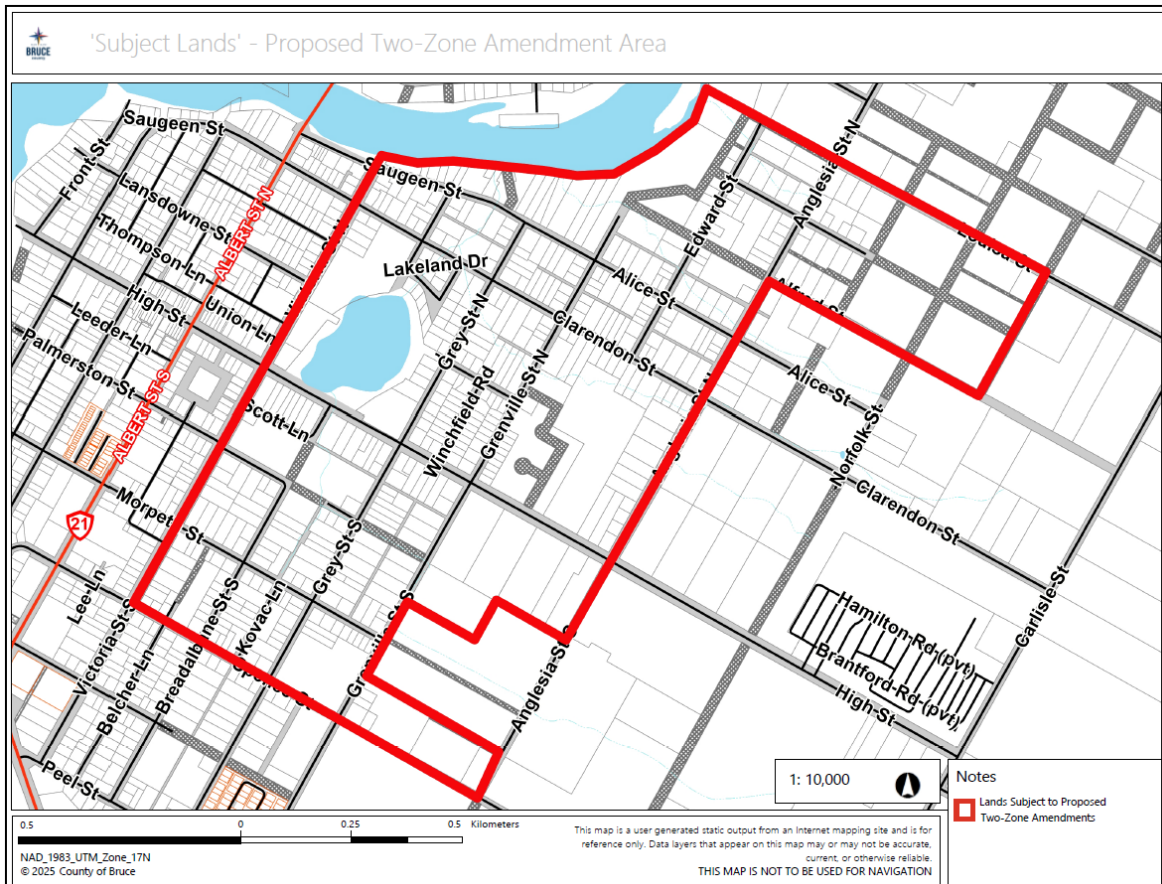
Southampton Two-Zone Floodplain Management Concept Town of Saugeen Shores

The Town of Saugeen Shores is proposing to amend the Local Official Plan and Zoning By-law to implement a Two-Zone Floodplain Management Concept for certain lands within the geographic Town of Southampton.
